

# Big plate with floral decoration in radiating panels

This is a large blue and white plate with a slightly curving rim. The plate belongs to a characteristic type of earliest Chinese porcelains produced for foreign markets (Wanli reign). Presumably, it belonged to a 18th-century European interior, designed under the influence of China-mania.
