

# Bowl with two fishes

Materials/Technique  
s: greyish white stoneware, olive green crackled glaze, moulded and incised decoration.

Dimensions: height: 4.1 cm  
diameter (mouth): 21.2 cm  
diameter (base): 9.9 cm

The outer ribbed surface of the plate is decorated with incised lotus leaves; its mouth rim is broad and flat. The base is glazed; the contour of the base rim is cut in a sharp angle. Only the base rim was left unglazed. (Longquan ceramics)
