


# Bowl with two fishes

## Chinese Collection

Accession Nr.:	5358 
Type:	vessel; pottery
Date of production:	13th century– mid-14th century Yüan dynasty
Place of production:	Zhejiang province, China
Materials/Techniques:	greyish white stoneware, olive green crackled glaze, moulded and incised decoration.
Dimensions:	height: 4.1 cm diameter (mouth): 21.2 cm diameter (base): 9.9 cm

The outer ribbed surface of the plate is decorated with incised lotus leaves; its mouth rim is broad and flat. The base is glazed; the contour of the base rim is cut in a sharp angle. Only the base rim was left unglazed. (Longquan ceramics)
