Dimensions: height: 15 cm

On a rectangular pedestal is a torso of a teppanom (an angel-like creature from Thai mythology). The arms are missing from the shoulders. The figure, made of fine-grained white porcelain, is covered with a crackled, bone-coloured glaze.
