

Brush holder with a fisherman and a man paying homage to an ascetic

The cylindrical vessel has a slightly narrowing base. Its slightly projecting mouth rim is cca. 1 cm broad. Most probably, it had a cover. On the mouth rim, there is a scroll motif resembling the decorative stripes of the blue and white wares.
