Materials:	porcelain
Techniques:	applied; glazed
Dimensions:	height: 3.9 cm diameter (mouth): 9.6 cm diameter (base): 3.7 cm

Such simple, small-size cups, used as teacups or brushwashers, were quite characteristic of the Song, Jin and Yuan periods. Its surface is completely coated with glossy light green glaze. Longquan ware.
