A standard vessel used in traditional Mongolian dining is the “silver bowl” (khalkha: möngön ayaga). This cup is made of wood, with a silver sheet lining the inside and the rim. The base of the vessel is reinforced with a carved and pierced silver covering. It forms a unit inventory numbers [HFM_65.70.1](#) and [HFM_65.74.1](#).
