

# Snuff bottle

## Mongolian Collection

Type: object for daily use; snuff bottle

Date of production: ca. 1900

Place of production: Mongolia

Materials: copper; silver

Dimensions: height: 12.8 cm

The flat, round body of the snuff bottle (Khalkha:  $x\bar{u}r\bar{o}g$ ) is made of copper. Its silver plug, similar to a lotus petal, is triple-segmented and decorated with rows of pearls and the leather cord is attached to it at the top and bottom. A metal spoon broke off.
