Intact, casted bronze knife with arched, single-sided blade. A rib is visible on the upper third of its flat handle, which is ended in a slightly oval ring. A horizontal band is attached to the lower end of its ring. A channel runs along the inner side of its handle. A stylized bird motif with rounded eye and curved beak is carved on the handle near the blade.
