Women's shirt, a kurta, made by shishadar phulkari technique. Shishadar technique involves the insertion of small mirrors into the embroidery. Phulkari originally meant floral embroidery, but later geometric designs were also designated with this word. Delicate embroidery, with floral and geometric ornaments, mirror inlay.
