20th-century reproduction of the mural painting of Anak Tomb No. 3 dated to the 4th century AD

Anak Tomb No.3 is situated in the valley of the Jaeryeong river; it was discovered during excavation works. It is the tomb of a Chinese general (Chinese name: Dong Shou). The murals in Dongsu's tomb fall into the category of genre scenes.

UNESCO included Goguryeo murals on the World Heritage List in 1994.
