Buddhism was introduced to the Korean peninsula in the 4th century AD. It arrived to Korea via China, and by the 6th century, it had become widespread on the entire peninsula and had been introduced to Japan as well. In Korean Buddhist art, the cult of the Seven Star Deities derives from a Taoist origin, introduced to Korea through Chinese Buddhism.
